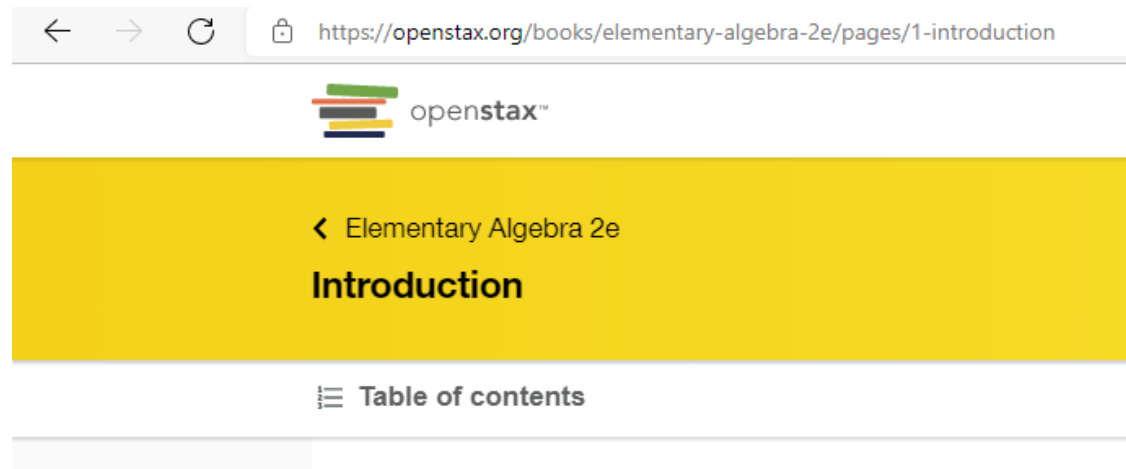
Tuition: \$200 ($\frac{1}{2}$ paid at registration, $\frac{1}{2}$ on first day of classes)

Printing the book is not required for the class. But you will need to access the book online for work at home. There may be other online assignments as well.



Materials: pencils, paper (lined and graph), ruler, scientific calculator (any TI-30x series will do at this level)
