CLASS FORMAT

Each week's teaching includes slides and short video clips about a region of the world. Students learn to take notes in class, do research, and give an oral presentation (in April). Parents are invited to attend their student's presentation day and sample foods from around the world on the last class day.

Students will complete maps of the entire world, in detail – including all countries, capital cities, and physical features. Map sets will be provided by the teacher.

The focus of this class is to encourage students to see the world as a mission field, where God is to be praised for His marvelous creations. Students will see the great need for hope in the hearts of men and the people groups waiting to hear the good news of the gospel of Christ.
